

**US Department of Agriculture (USDA)
Child and Adult Care Food Program (CACFP) and Adult Day Care Food Program (ADC)
Public Release Announcement**

During program year 2017-2018, children or adults enrolled in a sponsored USDA participating child care center, family day care home or adult day care center, may be eligible to receive Free and Reduced Price Meals benefits if your family's income qualifies. Emergency shelters, At-Risk After School Care Centers, foster children, Head Start participants or a member of a household receiving SNAP, FDPIR or TANF assistance are automatically eligible to receive free meal benefits.
